Some time ago I wrote to Tom Hine about a list of names published in the Hampshire Family Historian which were from the time your grandfather was in business as an Undertaker/Builder of Aldermaston. A very interesting thing to me is the name of your grandfather Robert CARTER, and looking at the dates 1886-1917 when the records were collected I wonder if this could be the same Robert CARTER that was baptised in Sutton Courtenay (near Abingdon) in 1862? This would span the years when he was 24-55 years old.

My interest in this possible link would be your great grandfather Thomas CARTER whose eldest son George is my great grandfather (see over for tree).

In her letter to me, Mrs. Rita Hine said that she thought you would be most interested to hear from me about this. I would of course be only too delighted to hear from you, to know if you could tell me anything about the CARTER family that long ago - especially Thomas.

Dear Mrs. Stanley,

I was most interested to receive your letter and the information about your family and the Caster family when they were in Liddington, Wilts. I was also most interested to see the tree and am most grateful for the details that it contains. Since writing to your cousin Ray, I have made some progress in confirming the ancestors of Thomas Caster - he was in fact ~~the~~ younger than I thought and furthermore was not baptised until he was one-year-old (on his first birthday) together with his new brother George who was just a month old. This took place in Andover, and I now have got links back to 1741 in the Andover area when Jonathan Caster married (a girl from a local family) called Elizabeth Sutton on 26/5/1741.

What seems exciting is that this Jonathan would have probably been in his 20's in 1741 when married, and possibly have travelled just 10 miles down the road from Shalbourne to Andover and may have been the younger brother of your Simon Caster (Bp. 13/6/1712)! This needs to be searched when I next can get some time at Winchester R.O. and I will let you know if the connection can be confirmed.

Once again, my grateful thanks for your help and interest and for the information about this possible connection over the Wiltshire border.

Obituary



A WOMAN who was born and spent her life in a north Hampshire town has died at the age of 97.

Kathleen (Kitty) Carter, formerly of Sandy Lane in Pamber Heath, Tadley, died at Marlfield nursing home, in Alton, on August 14.

Mrs Carter was born in Tadley in August 1910. She grew up in the town and attended Tadley Primary School in The Green.

She married William (Dabby) Carter in 1931 and had six children - Brian, Mervyn, Barry, Marion, Heather and Glenn.

Along with raising her children, Mrs Carter worked as a domestic, doing housework for local gentry.

Known as "Big Nanny", Mrs Carter was grandmother to 22, great-grandmother to 27 and had seven great-great-grandchildren.

In her later years, she lived in care homes in Bramley and Winklebury, before moving to Alton after suffering a fall.

Diana Carter, Mrs Carter's daughter-in-law, said: "Although the last few years of her life were spent in retirement homes, and under 24-hour nursing care in Alton, lots of people in Tadley knew and loved Kitty and will no doubt miss and remember her along with her family."

My name is Margaret Davis. I recieved some information from Derek Ward about the Plant and Carter family tree. Your information was very helpful. But what I need to know is do you have access to more. I'm sure you get alot of questions like this. Do you have access to the census in 1841. I'm trying to find out more about the Plants and Carters. I'll give you a list of what Derek told me,

You have a listing from Tumpike, what year----- and from where-----.

Do you know how this Carter family is related to the family in Baughurst house?

The only parish names I have is St Peter's and Baughurst parish, if that a help.

I found that Thomas and Walter Plant moved to Canada. They were listed in the 1871 census in Brantford. But I don't know when or how they came to Canada. Maybe a date is given as when they were last in Eng. Is there some way of finding out when and how they came over here. Is there such a thing as a destination declaration which tells of where they were going and how. Some one told me that they could have come from Liverpool or Southampton, but I need some idea of time so I can search passinger lists.

When I talked to the archives in Canada they were able to tell me that Thomas had died and that he left a will. In that will it stated that he was left a legecy from his late Aunt Jane Carter of Yew Tree Cottage (living at Baughurst house in 1841?). Is there any way to find record of this Aunt Jane Carter death and of her will.

I know I'm asking alot of questions, but let me know if it's possible for you to help, or if there is a way for me to get information. Also there was mention of Carter familys that are still in the area, are any of these related and if so could you please send me addresses so I could write them. Maybe they'd be interested in the other half of their family. I have lots of pictures of the Plants(from Walter on down, it would be nice to see if someone else would have pictures of the Carters).

So again thank you for all your help, please let me know if you can be of help with the Plant and Carter familys.

I am sending part of the Plant family tree, maybe that will help, so please make correction or additions if you can.
